

EduText Parent PINs are noted on your child's progress report, available through your

child's school site and listed on the ATLAS Parent Portal



For families with multiple Fresno Unified students, you will need to text 28527 (ATLAS) separately for each of your EduText Parent PINs.

Activation is immediate, updates will begin the following school day.

A-G REQUIREMENTS

The University of California (UC) and California State University (CSU) systems require that students complete at least 15 courses in the areas listed below to be considered for admissions. Courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. Additional coursework beyond the minimum requirements is strongly recommended.



A-G courses are a series of high school classes that students are required to successfully complete for eligible admission to the California State University and University of California systems. The goal of A-G curriculum is to ensure students have attained core subject knowledge that will fully and effectively prepare them for college. 

SUBSTANCE ABUSE COUNSELING

What is Prodigy?

Prodigy Healthcare Inc. provides evidence-based substance abuse counseling services for school districts. These services include Motivational Interviewing, Psychoeducation, Trauma Informed Treatment, Cognitive Behaviors Therapy & Relapse Prevention.

What type of services are provided?

Individualized one-on-one counseling sessions: screening, intake, assessments, treatment plan development, case management, crisis counseling, collateral (family), group counseling, discharging planning.

Who are the counselors?

Counselors hold, at minimum, a bachelor's degree in a health or human service-related field, such as psychology, sociology, criminology, social work, or child development. All counselors are also registered with the ACCBC (Addiction Counselor Certification Board of California) as a Certified Addiction Treatment Counselor (CATC) in compliance with Title 9, Division 4, Chapter 8 §13035(f) of the California Code of Regulations for Alcohol and Drug Counselor Certification. Prodigy's counselors are experienced in working with students on school campuses.

What does a typical day look like for a counselor?

Each of the school sites Prodigy serves is assigned a site counselor. That counselor reports to the school site daily. They work with the school staff, mostly administrators, to identify counseling needs for students. They devote most of the school day working with students that are pulled out of elective classes.

How do we measure success for students?

Success is measured by seeing a decrease in substance use and an increase in credit completion/graduation rates. Prodigy meets with school administrators once a month to discuss the success of the students in our program.

Counseling services during COVID-19

Prodigy offers online referrals (www.prodigyreferrals.com), telehealth services and in person services (if requested by the individual). Prodigy follows all guidelines issued by the CDC (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention).

Cost

Services are provided at no cost to the school districts, students, and their families.
